2.5.1 - Mechanism of internal assessment is transparent and robust in terms of frequency and mode.

Internal assessments are conducted frequently, with clear schedules set at the beginning of each semester. These schedules are communicated to students well in advance, helping them plan their study time effectively.

The internal assessment includes various modes such as written exams, assignments, quizzes, presentations, and practical evaluations, allowing students to demonstrate their learning in diverse ways. The question papers are prepared by the faculty in consultation with the respective departments, and the scheme of valuation is also approved by the Head of the Department, ensuring that evaluation standards are consistent and fair.

Faculty members evaluate answer sheets as per defined rubrics, and the results are shared with students within a specified timeframe. Any discrepancies or mistakes are addressed directly by the faculty in the classroom, promoting transparency. Additionally, internal assessment marks and attendance are uploaded periodically on the Anna University web portal, providing students and parents with real-time access to performance data. This transparency in assessment and the frequent feedback mechanism helps students track their progress and make necessary improvements throughout the semester.
