Additionally, they are based on Bloom's Taxonomy, a hierarchy of learning objectives, ensuring a comprehensive approach to student learning. The COs are developed through brainstorming sessions between the Heads of various departments and the subject faculty members.

Once the Program Educational Objectives (PEO), POs, PSOs, and COs are finalized and approved, they are disseminated to all stakeholders to ensure clarity on expectations. This communication helps students and faculty understand the desired knowledge, skills, and attitudes to be developed throughout the program. The outcomes are shared through discussions, informational sessions, and publications in both printed and electronic formats to all stakeholders. These outcomes are also made available on the college website for easy access.

To enhance understanding, the COs for each course are provided as pre-reading material in the curriculum, placed before the syllabus. This allows students and faculty to understand the expectations of the course, specifically the capabilities students should demonstrate by the end of the course. When framing assessment and evaluation questions, the COs are used to determine the appropriate allocation of marks, ensuring their alignment with the POs and PSOs.
